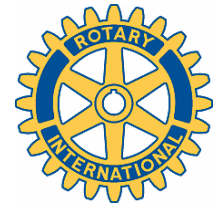

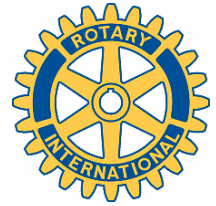

**Today's Program:**

Vic Oakes introduced our program, Jim Howard about "Hives of Howard"

Jim "Coach" started out with a very cute poem about bees. He introduced his assistants. He told us about his time telling 1st graders about bees and how they reacted. He told us about the important of bees. Yes, they make honey, but they also pollinate fruits and vegetables. It takes a bee 15 times pollinate a cucumber. He passed around samples of bees wax and honeycombs. He also brought an amazing bee hive with him with live bees in it. He told us about some ways that bee stings are helping people with arthritis, ms and allergies. Apitheraphy, which is bee sting therapy, is being done.

There are 300 unique types of honey. Productive queens can lay over 1,000 eggs per day and over 200,000 in a lifetime. Drones are the male bees, they don't sting or work, the mate with the Queen. In fact, the worker bees (the females) have to even feed the Drones or they will starve to death. The worker bees, the females, are the ones that sting and make the honey.

There are many diseases bees can face. Mites are in the breathing system of the bees, Small hives beetles also can kill bees. Wax moths lay its eggs in the honeycombs and destroys the comb. The Colony Collapse disorder has recently effective many bee hives and they don't know what is causing it. There are many different types of bees. He uses Italian, Buckbass and Starlines. He did mention that if you get stung by a bee the best thing to put on it is to mix water and meat tenderizer and rub on the sting. He then asked the members for any questions. There was a lot of buzz after his presentation. It was sweet!

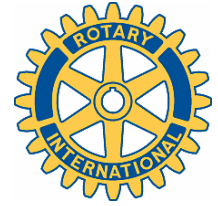
"Coach" brought two jars of honey to raffle off and the winners were Paul Hines and Diane Sokolowski. Thank you for bringing that to our meeting.
