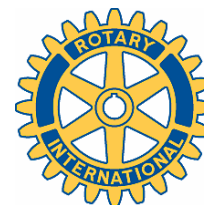

Today's Program:

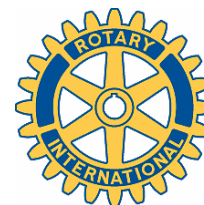

The OPTIONS program is for pregnant teens and young parents, providing support services to Oswego County pregnant and parenting teens up to 21. OPTIONS strive to promote the well being for both teens and their babies. Services are available Monday through Friday and their office located at the Oswego Midtown Plaza. Case Specialists meet with teens at home, in school and other community locations as well as their office. To get involved pregnant and parenting teens can contact OPTIONS themselves; or Agencies, family, or friends can contact them to refer a youth. Their services are free, voluntary and confidential.
