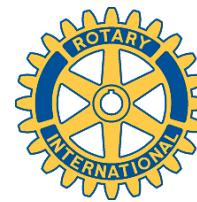

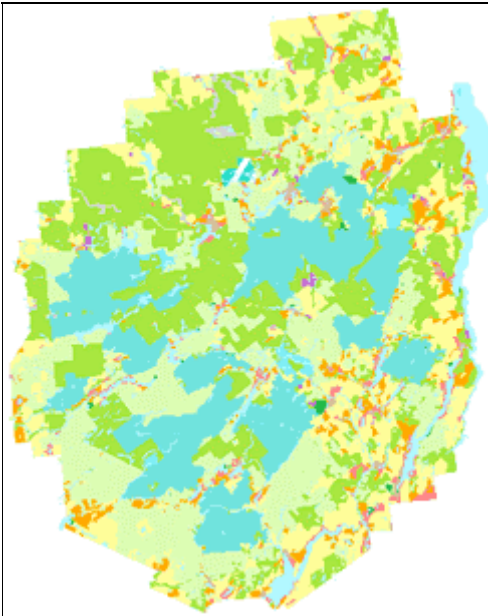

Today's Program: Bob Wood introduced our own Peter Kaulfuss, who spoke to us today about the "Adirondack Park." According to Peter, the Adirondack Park was created in 1892 by the State of New York amid concerns for the water and timber resources of the region. Today the Park is the largest publicly protected area in the contiguous United States, greater in size than Yellowstone, Everglades, Glacier, and Grand Canyon National Park combined. The boundary of the Park encompasses approximately 6 million acres, nearly half of which belongs to all the people of New York State and is constitutionally protected to remain "forever wild" forest preserve. The remaining half of the Park is private land, which includes settlements, farms, timberlands, businesses, homes, and camps. Essex and Hamilton Counties are completely included in the park. Part of 11 other NYS counties are included in the park as well, as are 13 incorporated villages: Dannemora, Keeseville, Tupper Lake, Saranac Lake, Lake Placid, Westport, Fort Henry, Ticonderoga, Speculator, Lake George, Corinth, Northville, and Mayfield. The Adirondack Park Agency (APA) was established in 1971 for the purpose of developing long-range land use for both public and private lands within the park. Peter stated that his interest in the Adirondack Park and the APA stems from his position as County Planning Director

for Fulton County several years ago along with his membership, at the time, in the "Local Government Review Board" representing Fulton County. Thanks for sharing your experiences and your knowledge about the park with us, Peter!
