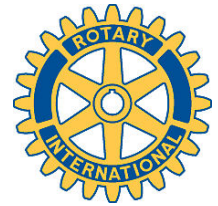

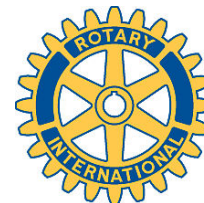

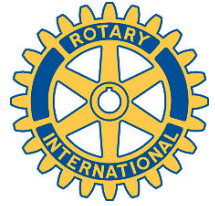

for the victories they've won.

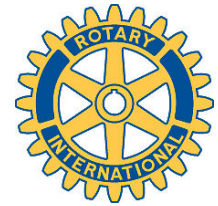
So, here's to the ROTARIANS,

**Today's Program:** Melanie Trexler introduced today's speaker, Perry Noun, in the following manner: "It is my great pleasure to introduce our speaker this afternoon – a man who is the voice of Central New York golf. He is currently the host of the popular radio show, now in its sixth season, known as "Tee Time With the ProNoun." A man who does more than cover golf, as he is an avid competitive golfer himself who has won more than 60 amateur golf tournaments, including the "Post-Standard Senior Amateur." An overall athlete who was inducted into the Ithaca College Athletic Hall of Fame and is a former major league baseball player with the Chicago Cubs organization. A man of energy, passion, and enthusiasm. A native son of Oswego who continues to make us proud." Melanie was certainly correct when she described Perry as a man of energy, passion, and enthusiasm. Perry took us from the 1940's to the present and charmed us with anecdotes and stories from each decade. During the 40's he mostly remembers "just growing up, having fun, and smiling a lot." The 50's were marked by his attendance at Ithaca College, the 60's by his signing with the Chicago Cubs (and playing with Lou Brock), the 70's by his starting a family in Syracuse and beginning his apartment/real estate management business (not to mention making a commitment to developing a good golf game), the 80's by seeing Tiger Woods on television, and the 90's by hosting his first morning talk show. During his talk, Perry quizzed us on events that occurred during these various times, and those who

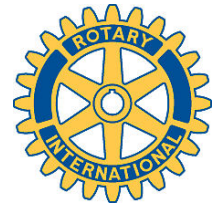

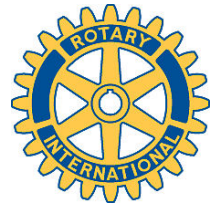
