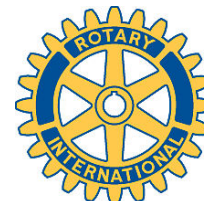

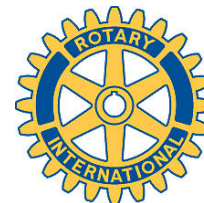

- ❖ Syracuse University Football Concession (the sign-up sheet is on Page 4). Looking for Rotarians for the 11/24 game.
- ❖ Youth Exchange Week will be held on November 29 – December 2 this year. Please contact Sabine Ingerson for further details. A sign-up sheet for volunteers was passed around today and will be available during the next couple of weeks.
- ❖ Our club will participate in this year's "Make A Difference Day" on Saturday, Oct. 27 by helping to clean up the tunnel walk on the east side of Oswego. All volunteers should meet at 8 a.m. at the E. First Street entrance to the tunnel. Also, a month-long effort to collect outerwear for needy residents and children has begun. Drop-off points are at Paul's Big M, Edward Jones, The Palladium-Times. If you can help with either of these projects, please contact Project Chair Stephen Wise. Make A Difference Day is the nation's largest day of giving. Last year, some 4.5 million participants engaged in projects that helped their communities.
- ❖ Due to the great interest in attending the Rotary/UN Day on Nov. 3rd at the United Nations, I paid for the charter bus with my personal Rotary credit card, to make sure we had transportation. It's looking like a full bus, which means that the bus cost will probably be only \$30 each. (Remember that the event registration is separate from this.) We are planning on picking up all those from the Western part of our District at Exit 38 in Liverpool at 4:00am, then picking up those in the Eastern part of our District at Exit 31 in Utica at 5:00am, in order to arrive at the U.N. by 9:00am. For the fourth consecutive year, there will also be a separate youth program for Interact, Youth Exchange, high school students, etc. and their adult chaperones, which will run from 9:30am to 11:30am, followed by lunch and an optional tour. If you haven't sent the form in yet, you need to do so ASAP, with a note that you've put a copy of the registration form and your check in the mail to them (don't wait past Oct. 24, as they had to turn folks away last year) and that you're coming down with the D-7150 Charter bus. You also need to fax that form to Bill Crist at 853-4636 so I have the names for our records for the bus. Today's Program: Roger Fox – NYS Federation of Search and Rescue. Roger explained that the all-volunteer organization was founded 36 years ago, largely in response to the failed search for a 3-year-old Baldwinsville boy. The group has participated in hundreds of searches, including the one for Heidi Allen in 1994 and for the ultralight pilot whose plane crashed about a week ago in Richland, Oswego County. Fox said that many searches are conducted outside of Oswego County because the county is ahead of the curve and is part of the county's emergency services effort, not an afterthought as it is in other counties. The group has 32 members.

Today's Trivia Note: Did you know that the New York State forest ranger assigned to Oswego County is Scott Jackson, who is stationed in Parish?

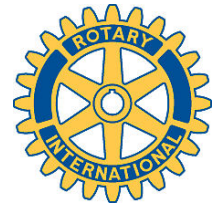

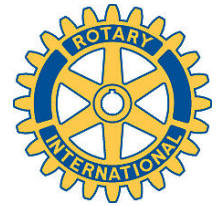

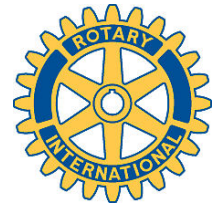
