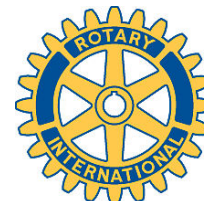

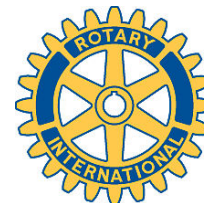
- ❖ Syracuse University Football Concession (the sign-up sheet is on Page 4). Rotarians are needed for the 11/24 game.

**Today's Program:** Ken Hayes of our club served as the guest speaker today and talked to us about the new Salvation Army building. According to Ken, obtaining a new building was a rather lengthy process. In 1999, the Salvation Army launched a capital improvement campaign, the result of which allowed the organization to purchase some land and take down some old structures – but did not generate sufficient monies to purchase or build a new structure. Approximately two years ago, however, the former Super Duper building on West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street became available. With the help of many, including the offer of a 40% discount on the selling price by the owner, the Salvation Army was able to take out a loan and purchase the building last spring. Renovations are being made at present, and it is expected that the "move" to this new structure will take place in early 2008. Ken is quite excited about the move, and says that the new building will give the Salvation Army a great deal more needed space. (They will be moving from a 4,000 square ft building to a 13,000 square ft building.) This move, for instance, will allow the Salvation Army to "offer more to people who are already in the building," not to mention the increased flexibility it will provide for the organization and the increased privacy it will afford everyone in the building. Ken summarized the benefits of the move by stating in closing that it "will definitely be of help in meeting both the spiritual and physical needs" of the people who use the resources of the Salvation Army. Thanks for a most interesting and informative talk, Ken – and good luck with your move!

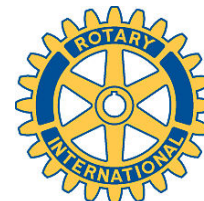

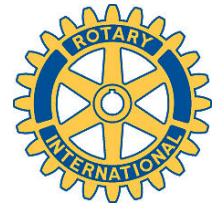
