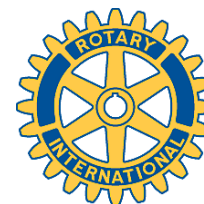

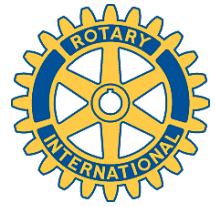

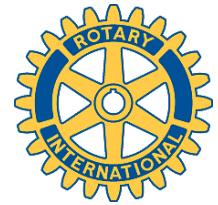

Today's Program:

Bill Crist introduced Judy Queale-Dunsmoor, president of sales and marketing for New York Bold LLC, as the guest speaker. Judy gave a history of how New York Bold LLC, made up of owners of the 13 onion farms in the county, was formed and how they successfully branded a selection of onions, called New York Bold, which became the first branded onions — “Onions with Attitude.” She explained that the soil in New York state is rich with pyruvic acid, which makes the onions a particularly pungent and gives them intense flavor. The branded onions, which are packaged in Volney, are known for their caramelizing quality, superior storage capability, high sugar and low water content, and health benefits. Judy also pointed out the onion consumption has more than doubled in the last 50 years and in Oswego County, 97 million pounds of onions are harvested per year, bringing in more than \$30 million dollars in the retail market.
