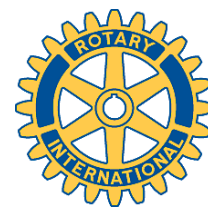

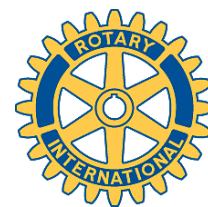

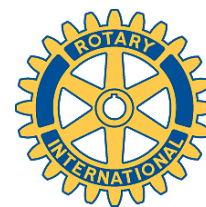
Today's Program: Sue Witmer introduced Dr. Daniel Larson, President of Cayuga Community College. Dr. Larson began by noting that CCC (as Cayuga Community College is often called) first began as Auburn Community College in 1953, but that not long afterwards its name was changed to CCC. In December 1978, CCC was authorized to offer courses in Oswego County; and in Spring 1994, CCC opened its extension site in Fulton, moving to its current location on the west side of Fulton in the summer. Within five years, the building was filled to its capacity (1300 or so students) and has continued to be filled since then. In 1997, the extension site was named an "Extension Center," and then in 2006 it was named a "Branch Campus" – which allows CCC to offer complete degree programs in Fulton. At present, 13 different degree programs are available for students to choose from at the Branch Center. Because of the continued "capacity" issues at the Branch Center, CCC has recently decided to expand its physical presence in Fulton and has submitted a proposal to purchase space in and around the "River Glen" area. Dr. Larson believes that this purchase will take place, and he anticipates that this "new campus" will open in Fall 2011. Thank you for a most informative and helpful presentation, Dr. Larson!

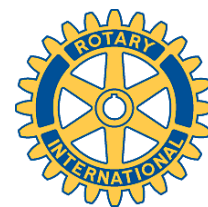
