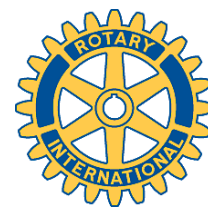

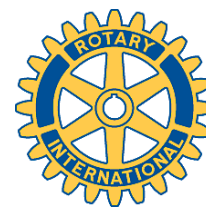

Not only was the operating budget for the Fort reduced, but (as we are all well aware), the Fort was placed on the Governor's "closing list" for a while this spring. Paul was most appreciative of the support the Fort received once it was announced that the Fort would close – from "The Friends of Fort Ontario" to countless local organizations to many local schoolchildren. The Fort was eventually taken off the list and opened on the Friday of Memorial Day Weekend. Although not all sections of the Fort are open and available to the public, and although some of the grass on the property remains uncut, the Fort is operating – and receiving quite a few visitors! As in the recent past, the Fort will be available for the children's activities this summer during Harborfest. A national French Revolution Reenactment will be held as well this summer, from August 13-15. The Arts and Kite Festivals will also be held in late summer, and the Fort's Ghost Tours are scheduled for fall. 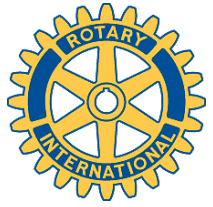
