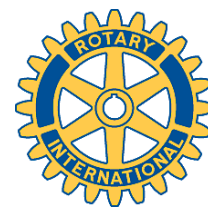

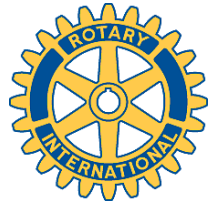

Today's Program: Rick Tesoriero introduced Pstachu Kohut, Agent-In-Charge of the U.S. Border Patrol Office in Oswego. Kohut began by describing the U.S. Border Patrol in general as the mobile uniformed enforcement arm of the Department of Homeland Security – a significant change from the Border Patrol's previous focus (prior to 9/11), which centered primarily on illegal immigration activities and issues. Now the focus is obviously on terrorism, i.e., to deter and apprehend terrorists and their weapons attempting to enter (or leave) the U.S. between its various ports of entry. Deterring and apprehending smugglers of humans, narcotics, and contraband is an additional significant responsibility of the Border Patrol. On the local level, i.e., Oswego., the Border Patrol's major responsibilities are as follows: to secure the border shoreline; to prevent the ingress of terrorists, illegal aliens, and narcotics; to secure routes of egress from border areas; to reduce criminal activity in the border areas; and to secure critical transit nodes. Thank you for giving us an informative presentation of a most significant activity, Kohut – and thank you for the services you and your staff provide our area!
