### **1. Continue raising awareness of current water issues and potential projects.**

**Strategy 1:** Research current Rotary initiatives and media reports (news papers, magazines, and web) for status on water issues.

**Strategy 2:** Inform membership on process for new projects, existing projects, and new information via District Conference, club presentations, Credo, 7150 web site, and emails to clubs.

**Strategy 3:** Show clubs information /pictures from completed projects and any current water issues.

### **2. Identify and recruit leadership ( presidents, ADGs, members) within clubs and areas to lead the process of initiating and finalizing projects.**

**Strategy 1:** Obtain the email and address listing from DG Larry of ADGs and Presidents to be able to communicate with them. Also obtain from DG Larry who he designates to assist on foundation grants.

**Strategy 2:** Create discussion on water projects at District conference and other major Rotary gatherings to identify persons who are interested in leading water projects ( at individual club, multiclub levels).

### **3. All clubs will participate in a water project. Over half the clubs participated in 2006-07.**

**Strategy 1:** Operationalize all of the above.

**Strategy 2:** Work with DG Larry and others on a proposed water project pledge to be rolled out at the District Conference.

### **4. Finalize any projects that were not completed in the last three years.**

**Strategy 1:** Contact the project chair and assist in any actions that will move the project forward.

### **5. Complete all required reports to Zone and share with district leadership and clubs.**

**Strategy 1:** Request all projects communicate on their progress via email with water chair. Email combined results (zone report) to district and clubs quarterly.
